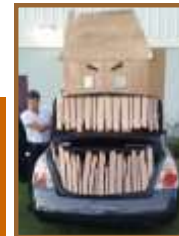
## PTP Message

## SAVE ON TUITION WITH EVERY SCRIP PURCHASE!!!

### ***What Is Scrip?***

Scrip is a term that means "substitute money". When you purchase scrip, you're purchasing negotiable gift certificates and prepaid cards that are used just like cash. You can use scrip to purchase everyday expenses like food, clothing, and other essentials, and with every purchase, you earn revenue for Trinity Lutheran School.

### ***How scrip help with your tuition payments***

The Great Lakes Scrip Center acts on behalf of churches, schools and other non-profit organizations to purchase large amounts of scrip from grocery stores, department stores, and other retailers. Because the scrip is purchased with cash up front, the participating retailers offer a substantial discount. Trinity Lutheran School buys the scrip from Great Lakes Scrip Center at a discount, and re-sells the certificates to families like yours for full face value. The discount - from two to fifteen percent or more - is Trinity's revenue. Half that revenue can be used for a child's tuition or for one of Trinity's tuition assistance or scholarship programs.

### ***Scrip is "shopping cart fundraising"***

Scrip is a popular fundraiser because families don't have to sell anything. Trinity parents and church members produce revenue by making regular household purchases they would make anyway. Groceries, clothing, toys, gifts, even gasoline can be purchased with scrip.
