Dear Parents and Students,

I was thrilled to welcome all of you "Back to School" at our Welcome Breakfast on August 7. I have never known such a wonderful attendance. There was such an amazing spirit of anticipation of another exciting school year, and I'm pleased to report that Trinity Lutheran School enjoyed a very smooth first week of school.

As you may have noticed, there have been several changes around campus over the summer as well as with schedules. Please make sure you check all paperwork your child's teacher sends home and remember to complete and return any important forms. It is very important that you also notify the office of any changes in your address, email address or phone numbers. I have had many letters and emails returned undeliverable—we MUST have current contact details.

Please remember if you are dropping of your child before 8am, sign them in to before care.

Please make sure you follow the drop off & pick up directions.

Very Important: As we are in the midst of hurricane season, even though it has been very quiet up to now, our school follows the lead of the Osceola School District. If

they cancel the Osceola public schools, then Trinity Lutheran School is also cancelled. We must hold school 180 days during the school year, so if a day is cancelled, it must be made up later in the year. Three Emergency Make-up Days are already built into the school calendar for the three days before Thanksgiving. Please keep alert to all weather reports on the radio, TV, and internet and watch for any notices of schools being open or closed from the Osceola School District. **Trinity Lutheran School will follow the lead of the Osceola School District. If the Osceola public schools are closed, then TLS is also closed!**
