Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Students,

As we are in the midst of hurricane season, it is important to know that our school follows the lead of the Osceola School District. If they cancel the Osceola public schools, then Trinity Lutheran School is also cancelled. We must hold school 180 days during the school year, so if a day is cancelled, it must be made up later in the year. Three Emergency Make-up Days are already built into the school calendar for the three days before Thanksgiving. Please keep alert to all weather reports on the radio, TV, and internet and watch for any notices of schools being open or closed from the Osceola School District. Trinity Lutheran School will follow the lead of the Osceola School District. If the Osceola public schools are closed, then TLS is also closed!

It is important for children to be in school for the full day. Federal Law states that children from kindergarten up must be in full time education. If you need to make appointments for medical or any other reasons, try to make them outside school hours. Children arriving late or leaving early are missing out on valuable tuition time as well as possibly disrupting the class routine.

If you have questions or concerns regarding your child's performance or behavior please schedule an appointment with your child's teacher thru email, schoolworx or by leaving a voice mail. Please under-

stand that arrivals and or dismissals are not the time to talk to teachers.

Garden of Hope tutoring started last Wednesday. If you want your child to participate, please either contact their teacher or the office. This is a wonderful FREE opportunity for your child to receive extra help and assistance in areas they may be struggling. Spaces are limited.

If your child receives a scholarship there is some information that you should be aware. Student must abide the attendance policy. The parent or guardian listed on the check must endorse the check upon notification by the school that the check is available. If the cost to attend the participating private school is more than the student's funding amount for that academic year, the parent is responsible for the difference. Failure to do one of this may result in loss of scholarship. If you have any question please stop by the office.
