READ S'MORE BOOKS!

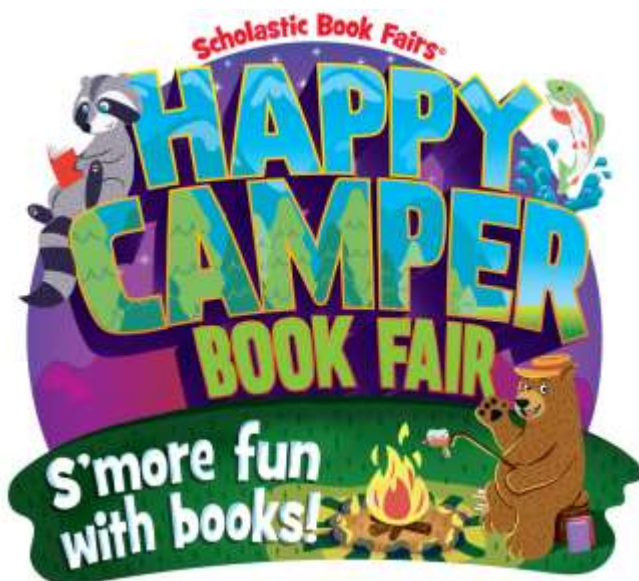
February 21, 2017 at 6:00 pm to 7:30 pm
