Dear Parents and Students,

Happy New Year! I hope everyone had a wonderful Christmas and on behalf of everyone at Trinity would like to send best wishes and blessings for a healthy and happy 2017.

I can't believe we are half way through the school year!

It has been a very exciting start to the 2016 – 2017 school year, with us welcoming some new students who, within a couple of days of starting, felt as if they had been here forever. Thank you everyone who helped make them feel so welcome, so proving once again that Trinity is one big happy family. We would also like to welcome Oliver, a student from Korea who will be spending January with us in 5th grade so that he can learn about our culture and we can learn about his and at the same time help him with his English.

We are beginning to plan for next year. Registration packets was sent home before the Christmas break and registration for present Trinity students is now open. Registration will open for members of Trinity Lutheran Church and siblings of current students on January 13th. Registration will open to the public on January 27th. We already have several students who have enrolled and anyone who registers by the end of January will receive 20 Tiger Tickets and 3 NUTS day passes to

be used by February 17th. Please help us to continue to increase enrollment next year by referring friends and relatives who may be considering a Christian School environment for their children. After they enroll, you will receive a referral discount of \$250 on your child's 2nd semester school costs (The referral discount does not apply to the VPK program).

If you received a Step Up Scholarship last year, please make sure you have applied to have it renewed this year – it is not automatic! Pre-K families should also check out the website www.StepUpForStudents.org. Scholarships pay much of the cost for your child to attend a private school. This year many of our students received up to \$5866 to pay private school tuition. We want you to register your Pre-K child in our kindergarten and I encourage everyone to check the website.

If you would like to be part of judging the Science Fair on February 2, please contact Mrs. Jenkins. Directions and guidelines will be provided.

If you have any concerns regarding your child's grades or the education they are receiving here at Trinity please make sure you contact their teacher to arrange a conference. It is very important that you update your phone numbers and email address in the main school office.
