Dear Parents and Students,

It is extremely important we have your correct phone numbers and email addresses as we will soon be starting a new grading and communication

program where you will be able to access all grades and information on your cell phone and computer.

Please remember if you are dropping off your child before 8am, sign them in to before care.

Please make sure you follow the drop off & pick up directions.—see reverse of paper for further directions. Tiger Town is no longer used for After Care.

Very Important: As we are in the midst of hurricane season, even though it has been very quiet up to now, our school follows the lead of the Osceola School District. If they cancel the Osceola public schools, then Trinity Lutheran School is also cancelled. We must hold school 180 days during the school year, so if a day is cancelled, it must be made up later in the year. Please keep alert to all weather reports on the radio, TV, and internet and watch for any notices of schools being open or closed from the Osceola School District. Trinity Lutheran School will follow the lead of the Osceola School District. If the Osceola public schools are closed, then TLS is also closed!
