Dear Parents and Students,

Can you believe we've already been in school this year for two weeks? Our school is once again rated 5 Stars on several web sites for prospective parents. I'm sure everyone had a wonderful time at the Welcome Back Wet Fun Afternoon—what a great start to the new school year.

Several extracurricular clubs and activities are already organized and others will soon be starting, including some exciting new clubs. Please keep listening to announcements and reading the Tiger Tales for schedules and information. Sponsors will make forms available for students to take home for parents to sign to grant permission to join a particular club. All fees are due upon completion of permission form. Students need to listen carefully to their teachers for information on joining these clubs. There is a fee to join a club or activity. This pays for all the club expenses. All students participating must have a C grade or higher. Please contact the school office at 407-847-5377 or the club sponsor if you have questions. When the clubs ends, if a parent is not there to pick up their child, they will be taken to after care and charged accordingly.

Please make sure your child arrives at school on time. If they arrive after 8:15am you must sign them in to the main office. 5 tardies in a 9 week period will result in a referral.

At the start of every new school year it always takes a while for parents to get used to procedures regarding dropping off, picking up and parking. When dropping your child off you must follow the one way system and drop them off where the patrols are waiting, next to the art room. Please do not park in front of the playground, walk them in to school and then drive out

the same way—we have too many cars coming in that way. Also if you must park in the church parking lot, that is a one way system, drive in near the church main doors and leave at the other end of the parking lot. All directions are attached to the student handbook that everyone received last week. Please remember, our students' safety is our main concern. If you have any questions, please see me. Thank you for your support.

In cases of threatening weather, in order to make the safest possible arrangements for students, dismissal may be delayed. We will follow the recommended State "30-30 Rule" - if thunder is heard within 30 seconds of lightning strike, the students will not be dismissed until 30 minutes has passed from the last sound of thunder. Students will therefore be retained in their classrooms until the storm has passed. **However, parents and guardians may sign out their child during this situation at their own risk.** In the case of heavy rain, grades 2nd & 3rd will be dismissed from the Life Centre.

This year we are once again awarding Random Acts of Kindness to students and faculty who are caught being especially helpful and kind to others. Who will be the first student to receive such an award as well as a Trinity Spirit T-Shirt? All nominated will have their names posted in the life Center and one every week will randomly be selected to receive a T-Shirt.

**On Monday, August 21<sup>st</sup>, during the Solar Eclipse we will be following the directions of Osceola public school, in that all outdoor activities will be canceled. As the time frame is from 1:15pm with full eclipse being at 2:50pm, which is also our dismissal time, you may sign your child out early and they will be excused. But if you choose to keep them off the whole day that will be unexcused and they will be responsible to make up all missed work.**

## School Uniform Policy

School uniforms are required for students in grades K-10.

Pre-K students are expected to wear red T Shirts or polo shirts.

All K-10 students must have an “official uniform” for Chapel which is the combination of a maroon polo shirt with the school logo and khaki shorts, pants, skirts or skorts.

The other uniform colors include navy blue, light blue polo shirt with the school logo plaid shorts, pants, skirts and skorts, khaki or navy and should not have logos, rivets or extra pockets on the sides (sweat pants are not acceptable). Middle school students may wear pink or black polo shirts with the school logo in addition to the above colors as part of their uniform. High School students may also wear white polo shirts.

Plain Black or Plain White Sneakers or shoes must be worn with socks at all times.
