Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Students,

Parents are responsible for the regular attendance of their children who are within the compulsory attendance age (6-16) as provided in Section 1033.21, Florida Statues. In the last couple of weeks there have been many absences or students have left early consecutively. As per our handbook page 10 any prolonged absences in excess of ten (10) per semester must be accompanied by a note from a doctor. Failure to do so will result in the student failing the course and no credit will be given unless there are extenuating circumstances. The note from the doctor must be turned in to the office on the first day of the student's return, they will not be accepted after this time. Please remember when students are absent, tardy or leave early they are missing out on valuable teaching time that cannot be made up and therefore are missing out on valuable grades. We are by law obliged to report constant/repetitive absences to the county.

Have you completed your background check? To be able to participate in school events, field trips or volunteer around school you must complete a check every year. Forms are available in the office.
