PTP are selling Valentines Grams every day in the Life Center for delivery on Wednesday February 14.

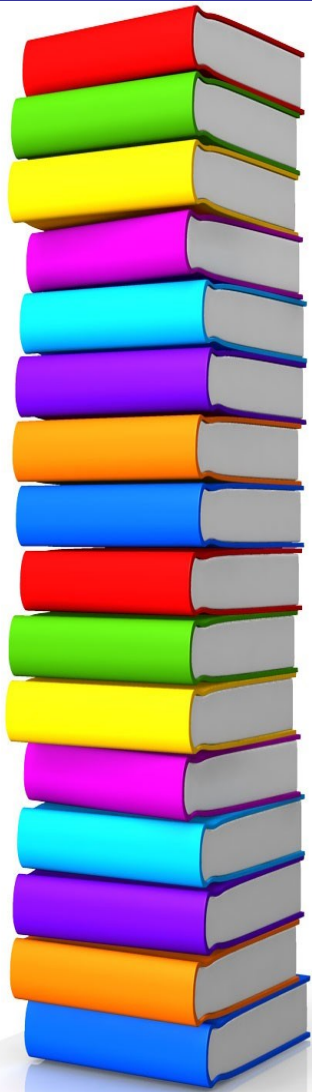
Science Fair and Geography Bee Awards will be presented after Chapel on Wednesday 21st.
